

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

DISPLAY UNIT INSTALLATION

1. Connect the antenna.
2. Using the Velcro pads provided, mount the display unit to the side of your refrigerator, or as close as possible.
3. If you have multiple refrigeration units, the display should be located between the refrigeration units. Large metal objects can block the signal path.
4. Connect the black 10-ft. foot power cord to the display unit. It is normal for the connection to feel slightly loose. **DO NOT APPLY EXCESSIVE FORCE THE POWER CONNECTOR.**
5. Use the peel-and-stick cable strain relief to secure the power cable in place.
6. Finally, connect the black charging adapter and plug it in to a nearby power outlet.



CELLULAR BACKUP ROUTER INSTALLATION

1. Install the Verizon USB 3G/4G modem as illustrated.
2. Connect the white power cable and charging adapter. Plug the charging adapter in to a nearby power outlet.
3. Slide the "Power" switch to the "ON" position. The power switch is located near the power connector.
4. Confirm that the 3G/4G switch is in the "3G/4G" position. This switch is located directly across from the power switch.
5. Using the Velcro pads provided, mount the router and modem as illustrated in the photo.
